

SAVE LIVES CLEAN YOUR HANDS

Your 5 moments for hand hygiene at the point of care*



1	BEFORE PATIENT CONTACT	WHEN? WHY?	Clean your hands before touching a patient when approaching him/her. To protect the patient against harmful germs carried on your hands.
2	BEFORE A CLEAN/ASEPTIC PROCEDURE	WHEN? WHY?	Clean your hands immediately before any clean/aseptic procedure. To protect the patient against harmful germs, including the patient's own, from entering his/her body.
3	AFTER BODY FLUID EXPOSURE RISK	WHEN? WHY?	Clean your hands immediately after an exposure risk to body fluids (and after glove removal). To protect yourself and the healthcare environment from harmful patient germs.
4	AFTER PATIENT CONTACT	WHEN?	Clean your hands after touching a patient and her/his immediate surroundings, when leaving the patient's side. To protect yourself and the healthcare environment from harmful patient germs.
5	AFTER CONTACT WITH PATIENT SURROUNDINGS	WHEN?	Clean your hands after touching any object or furniture in the patient's immediate surroundings when leaving—even if the patient has not been touched. To protect yourself and the healthcare environment from harmful patient germs.
