

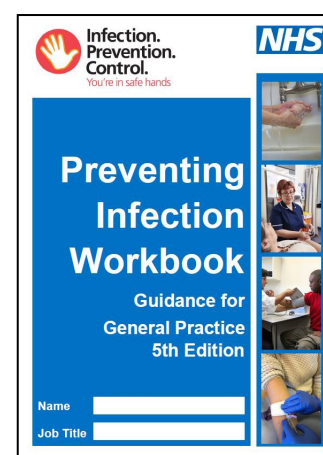
## Preventing Infection Workbook: Guidance for General Practice
